Quarterly Report of the Financial Status of UN-Habitat (HSP/CPR/66/4)

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Notes to the Statement of Financial Performance for the Period ended 30th June 2017

1. Introduction

This financial status contained in the annexes is presented as at 30th June 2017 and provides an overview of UN-Habitat's financial performance for the period then ended. The statement is based on International Public-Sector Accounting Standards.

2. Aggregate Results

2.1. Revenue

Total revenue at the end of the second quarter, comprising of the regular budget, foundation general purpose, programme support, foundation special purpose and technical co-operation amounted to \$72.5 million (2016-Q2: \$72.2 million). Of this amount, \$11.6 million which is 16.1% was from core funds (2016-Q2: \$16.2 million) while \$60.9 million which is 83.9% was from earmarked resources (2016-Q2: \$56.0 million).





Figure 1: Revenue by Source of Fund





2.2. Expenditure

2.2.1. Budgeted expenditure

Total annual expenditure budget for the year 2017 amounted to \$241.5 million (Biennium: \$482.3 million) of which \$49.1 million which is 20.3% relates to core (Biennium: \$97.5 million) and \$192.4 million which is 79.7% relates to earmarked activities (Biennium: \$384.8 million).

2.2.2. Allotted budgeted expenditure

Out of the total operating expenditure budget of \$241.5 million, a total of \$162.8 million was allotted and released representing 67.4%. This allotted amount represents \$21.8 million (13.4%) relating to core and \$140.9 million (86.6%) relating to earmarked activities.

2.2.3. Actual expenditure

Total actual expenditure amounted to \$75.6 million (2016-Q2: \$72.2 million) of which \$14.8 million representing 19.4% is for core funds (2016-Q2: \$16.2 million) while \$60.7 million (80.6%) is for earmarked funds (2016-Q2: \$56.0 million). This represents about 31.3% execution rate on the WP&B annual budget (39.5% inclusive of commitments) and 46.4% on period allotted and released budget (58.7% inclusive of commitments.

Figure 3: Expenditure by Source of Fund





Figure 4: Expenditure distribution by Segment




3. Performance of Core Funds

Core funds comprise of the regular budget, foundation general purpose and programme support. As at the reporting date, total core funds results were as follows:

Amended Version

3.1. Revenue

Total core revenue, comprising of the regular budget, foundation general purpose and programme support amounted to \$4.9 million. Regular budget amounted to \$5.0 million, foundation general purpose amounted to \$1.8 million (of which Voluntary Contributions amounted to \$1.0 million) while programme support accounted for \$4.8 million.



3.2. Budgeted core expenditure

Total budgeted core operating expenditure for the year amounted to \$49.1 million. This comprised of \$11.6 million of regular budget (23.6%), \$22.8 million foundation general purpose (46.4%) and USD 14.7 million programme support (30.0%).

3.3. Allotted core expenditure budget

Of the allotted core budget of \$21.8 million, \$11.6 million (53.2%) represented regular budget, \$4.8 million (22.0%) represented foundation general purpose while \$5.4 million (24.8%) was for programme support.

3.4. Actual core expenditure:

Total actual core expenditure amounted to \$14.8 million which was 44.4% of the allotted budget. Regular budget expenditure of \$5.1 million represents 35.0% of total core expenditure and is 43.6% allotted budget execution. Foundation general purpose amount of \$4.5 million is 31.0% of total core expenditure and represents 94.4% allotted budget execution rate. Expenditure of \$5.2 million on programme support is 38.0% of total core expenditure and represents an 96.3% allotted budget execution rate.




Figure 6: Core Expenditure Distribution


4. Performance of Ear-marked Funds

Ear-marked funds comprise of the foundation special purpose fund and technical cooperation fund. As at the reporting date, total earmarked funds results were as follows:

4.1. Revenue

Total ear-marked revenue, comprising of the foundation special purpose and technical cooperation amounted to \$60.9 million. Foundation special purpose amounted to \$13.4 (22.0%) million while technical cooperation accounted for \$47.5 million (78.0%).





4.2. Budgeted ear-marked expenditure

Total budgeted earmarked operating expenditure for the reporting period amounted to \$192.4 million. This comprised of \$45.2 million (23.5%) of foundation special purpose budget and \$147.2 million (76.5%) of technical cooperation budget.


4.3. Allotted ear-marked expenditure budget:

Of the allotted budget of \$141.0 million, \$26.8 million (19.0%) represented foundation special purpose while \$114.2 million (81.0%) was for technical cooperation.

4.4. Actual earmarked expenditure:

Total actual ear-marked expenditure for the period amounted to \$60.8 million which was 43.1% of the allotted budget. Foundation special purpose expenditure of \$16.1 million represents 26.0% of total ear-marked expenditure and is 60.2% allotted budget execution. Expenditure of \$44.7 million on technical cooperation is 74.0% of total ear-marked expenditure and represents a 39.1% budget execution rate.

5. Fund balances and reserves

5.1. Core Funds

Total core fund balances and reserves at the end of the reporting period amounted to \$18.6 million representing 3.3 million foundation general purpose and \$15.3 million programme support. No fund balances are realised for regular budget.

5.1.1. Foundation general purpose fund balances

Total fund balances of \$3.3 million include a mandatory reserve of \$4.5 million. This means that UN Habitat has exhausted its spendable fund balance as at the end of the second quarter.

The negative balance position of \$1.2 million is temporary and is due to a timing difference as the forecast contributions from Member States and cost recovery revenue is expected to guarantee non-expenditure of the mandatory reserve. However, should the respective Member States not pay the contributions, Management will request the policy organs for authorisation to spend part of the mandatory reserve.

5.1.2. Programme support fund balances

The Programme support fund balances of \$15.3 million include a mandatory reserve of \$2.9 million. Spendable fund balances available at the end of the period amount to \$12.3 million.

5.2. Ear-marked Funds:

Total ear-marked fund balances and reserves at the end of the reporting period amounted to \$372.3 million representing \$106.3 million for foundation special purpose and \$266.0 million for technical cooperation.

5.2.1. Foundation special purpose fund balances

The Foundation special purpose fund balances of \$106.3 million include a reserve of \$4.0 million. Spendable fund balances available at the end of the period amount to \$102.3 million.

5.2.2. Technical cooperation fund balances

The Technical cooperation fund balances of \$266.0 million include a reserve of \$11.4 million. Spendable fund balances available at the end of the period amount to \$254.6 million.

6. Conclusion

A summary of the revenue, expenses, fund balances and reserves is provided in Annex A, while the comparison of actuals and budget is shown in Annex B. Details of non-earmarked and earmarked contributions are given in Annexes C to F.

The financial position of the Foundation General Purpose continues to deteriorate. While the forecast shows that the mandatory reserve is likely to be maintained, any failure to realise the expected contributions from the respective Member States is likely to cause management to approach the policy organs for authorisation to spend part or all of the mandatory reserve. Meanwhile, in order to alleviate the negative effect of lack of cash in this fund, management may need to arrange a cash loan from other funds that have adequate cash resources.


