What are Best Practices?

UNGA (1995) definition:

Initiatives which have made outstanding contributions to improving quality of life in cities and communities

- Have a demonstrable and tangible impact on improving people's quality of life ¹/₂
- Are the result of effective partnerships between the public, private and civic sectors of society
- Are socially, culturally, economically and environmentally sustainable







Criteria used by the DIABP




- **Impact:** A best practice should demonstrate a **positive and tangible** impact on improving the living environment of people <u>particularly the poor and disadvantaged</u>.
- **Partnership:** Best Practices should be based on a partnership between at least two of the major actors.
- **Sustainability:** Best practices should result in lasting changes
- Leadership & Community Empowerment:
 - Leadership in inspiring action and change, including change in public policy;
 - Empowerment of people, neighbourhoods and communities and incorporation of their contributions;
- Gender Equality and Social Inclusion
- Innovation
- Transferability



- Provides key qualitative information for flagship reports, including forthcoming Quadrennial report.




Discussion on Best Practices peaked 1995 when UN-Habitat and Dubai Municipality organized the International Conference on Best Practices in Improving Living Environments (Dubai, 19-22 Nov 1995).

Best Practices & Local Leadership Programme (BLP, now Best Practices Unit) was established in 1997 in response to the **call of the Habitat Agenda to make use of information and networking in support of its implementation.**








Thematic distribution of submissions



Challenges	Proposed considerations/actions
Need for more systematic management of practices	Best Practices Unit coordination function; Knowledge Management Strategy; Quito Implementing Platform; systematic learning from partners for extremal and internal use
Reliance by BPU on only one source of funding and best practice identification (Dubai Award)	Quito Implementation Platform, UN-Habitat as a hub for implementing practices; identification of other incentives to collect practices
Potentials of BP in Agency mandate to be raised	Medium-term strategy; fund raising strategy; Well- defined and coordinated efforts, including at WUFs
Distinction between 'best' 'good' & 'promising' practices	Discussion of terminology as required
Standards and perceptions of what is a best practice shifting quickly over time	Usage of Artificial Intelligence and other means of analysis and regular verification
Limited follow-up on impact and results	Mechanisms for monitoring and evaluation





On the overall management of best practices:

- 1. Consolidate and systematize the overall BP management
- 2. Broaden mechanisms to **generate, manage and disseminate** best practices
- 3. New mechanisms for **information sharing** between Member States
- 4. Activate the **best practices partnership**
- 5. Increase qualitative contribution of best practices
- 6. Capacity development strategies to apply best practices and policies.
- 7. Strengthen **regional and national strategies**
