#### STAFFING IN UN-HABITAT AS AT 31 MARCH 2018

#### REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The report describes the staffing situation at UN-Habitat for the first quarter of the year 2018 as at 31 March 2018.

#### A. Professional Posts

#### 1. Regular Budget

There are 49 established professional posts under the Regular Budget for the biennium 2018-2019, 42 posts or 85.7 per cent were occupied as at 31 March 2018, with 7 posts or 14.3 per cent at various stages of recruitment.

#### 2. Extrabudgetary Resources

#### a) Habitat and Human Settlements Foundation (General Purpose)

There are 38 active Foundation General Purpose professional posts, of which 28 posts or 73.7 per cent were occupied as at 31 March 2018, and no posts under recruitment. UN-Habitat continues to take a cautious approach to new recruitments, considering the availability of funds.

#### b) Foundation Programme Support

There were 6 active Foundation programme support posts, 4 posts or 66.7 per cent were occupied, with 2 posts or 33.3 per cent under recruitment as at 31 March 2018.

#### c) Technical Cooperation Programme Support

There were 25 active technical cooperation programme support posts, 21 posts or 84 per cent were occupied, with 4 posts or 16 per cent under recruitment as at 31 March 2018.

#### d) Habitat Programme Managers (HPMs)

As at 31 March 2018, 8 countries were supported by Habitat Programme Managers.

#### 3. Junior Professional Officers (JPOs)

As at 31 March 2018, there were 6 JPOs working in UN-Habitat, 5 JPOs based in Nairobi, and 1 JPO at the Regional Office for Arab States in Cairo.

#### 4. Total professional staff at UN-Habitat

**Annex I** provides a summary of approved and occupied professional (international and national) posts in UN-Habitat by source of funding. As at 31 March 2018 there were a total of 227 active professional posts of which 192 or 84.6 per cent were occupied, giving an overall vacancy rate of 15.4 per cent.

#### **B.** General Services Posts

#### 5. General Service Posts

As at 31 March 2018, there were a total of 110 active General Services and related posts, of which 104 posts or 94.5 per cent were occupied. The overall vacancy rate was 5.5 per cent.
