- Corporate standards and quality assurance
- Innovations for efficient and effective capacity building

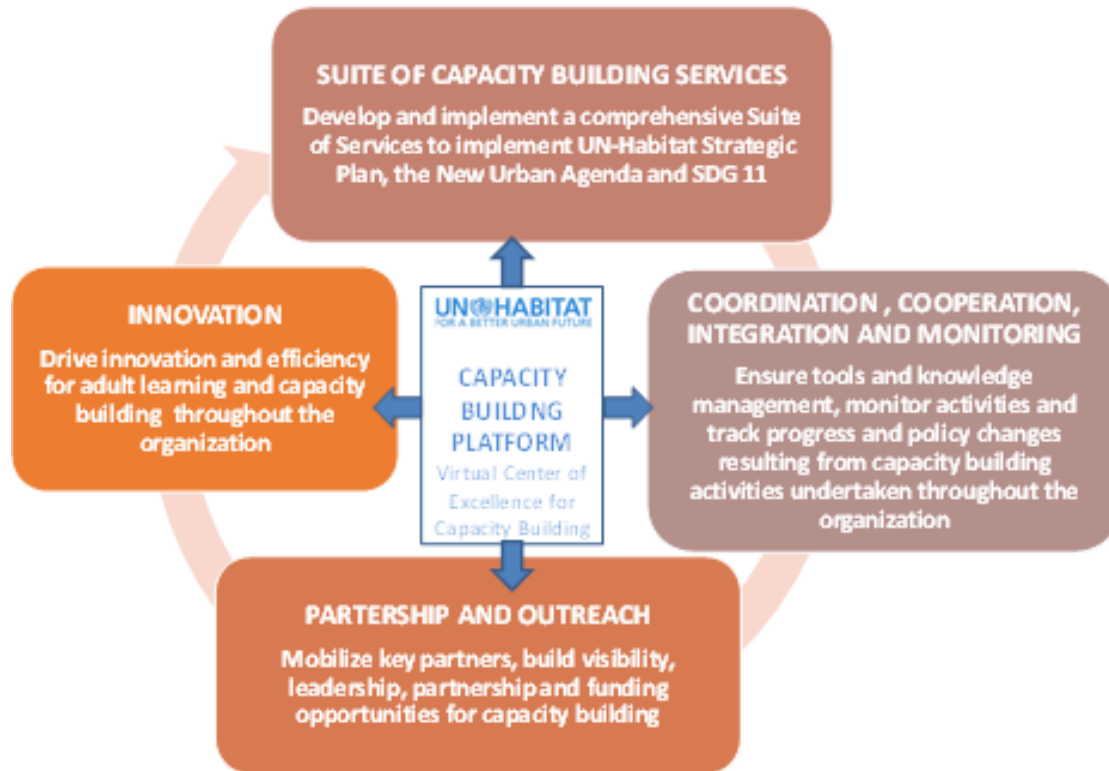


Target groups

2. Improve the delivery of capacity building services to Member States and local governments and other key urban stakeholders

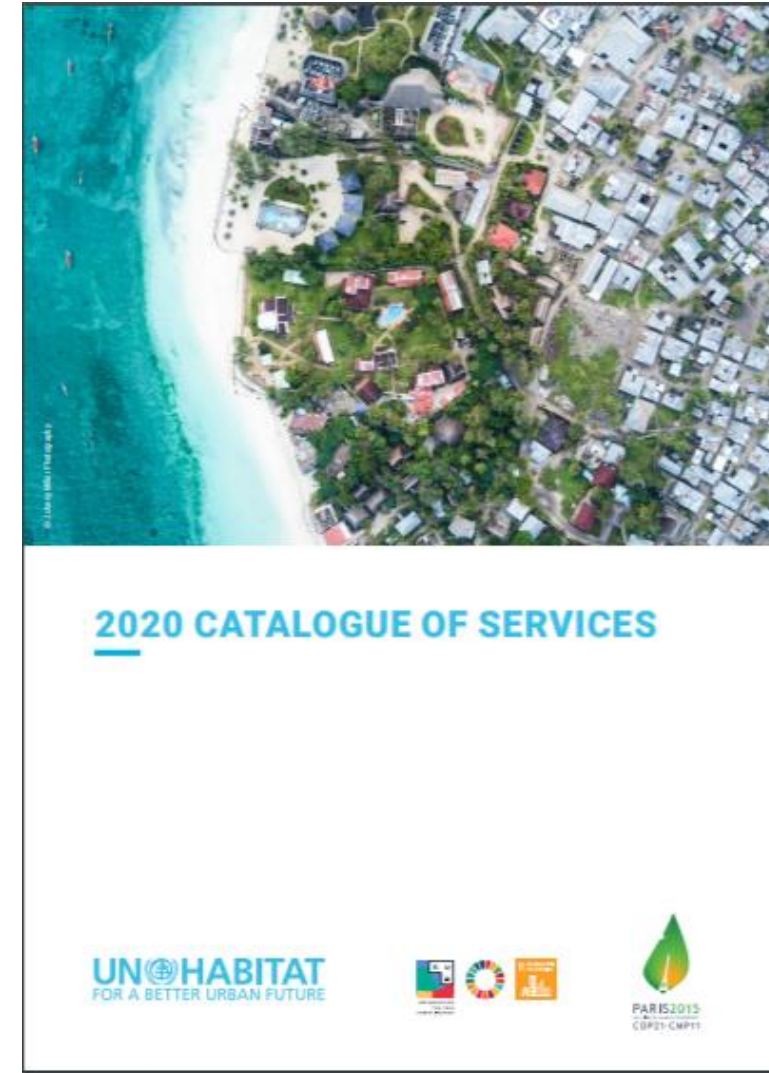
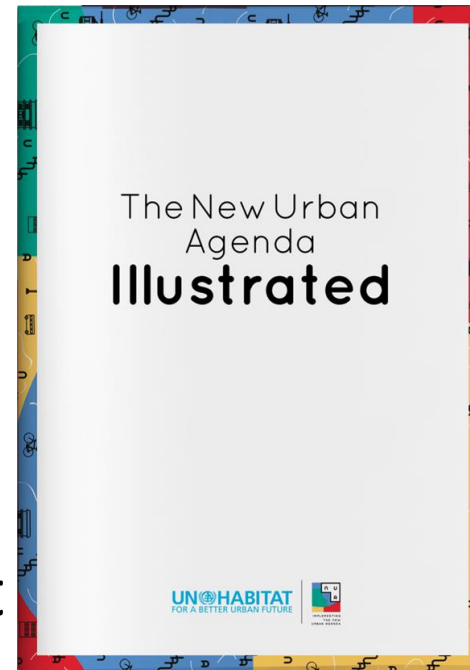
Draft Implementation Plan 2021
