A results-oriented advocacy and action platform

Improve the collective knowledge of sustainable urbanization through inclusive open debates and the exchange of best practices and policies.

Raise awareness of sustainable urbanization among stakeholders and constituencies, including the general public.

Increase coordination and cooperation within the UN System and with different stakeholders and constituencies for the implementation of NUA and the SDGs.

Provide substantive and strategic inputs from multilateral organizations, national and subnational governments, and stakeholders into the reporting on NUA implementation.







WUF10 Outcome Evaluation



WUF10 has proved to be a highly successful conference that has achieved its thematic and its strategic priorities. The expected accomplishments of the WUF10 are highly valuable and can be considered completed from the before-event perspective. 

WUF11 Theme


Transforming Our Cities for a Better Urban Future

WUF is committed to incubate scalable initiatives in the pursuit of sustainable urbanization through Legacy Initiatives.

Various WUF legacy initiatives were initiated in Abu Dhabi in 2020, such as the WUF Alumni Network and the City Investment Platform.

UN-Habitat initiated discussions with the Government of Poland and Katowice on the specific legacy initiatives of WUF11.


