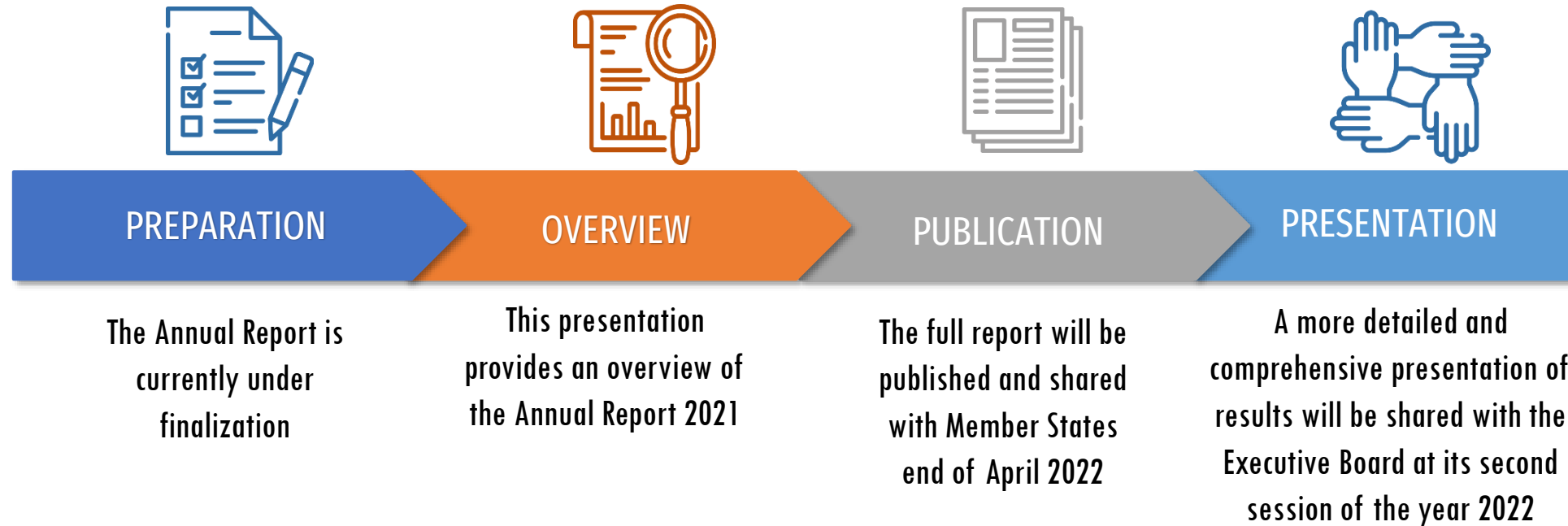

The new organizational structure and choices made by UN-Habitat have strengthened integrated programming and increased synergies.

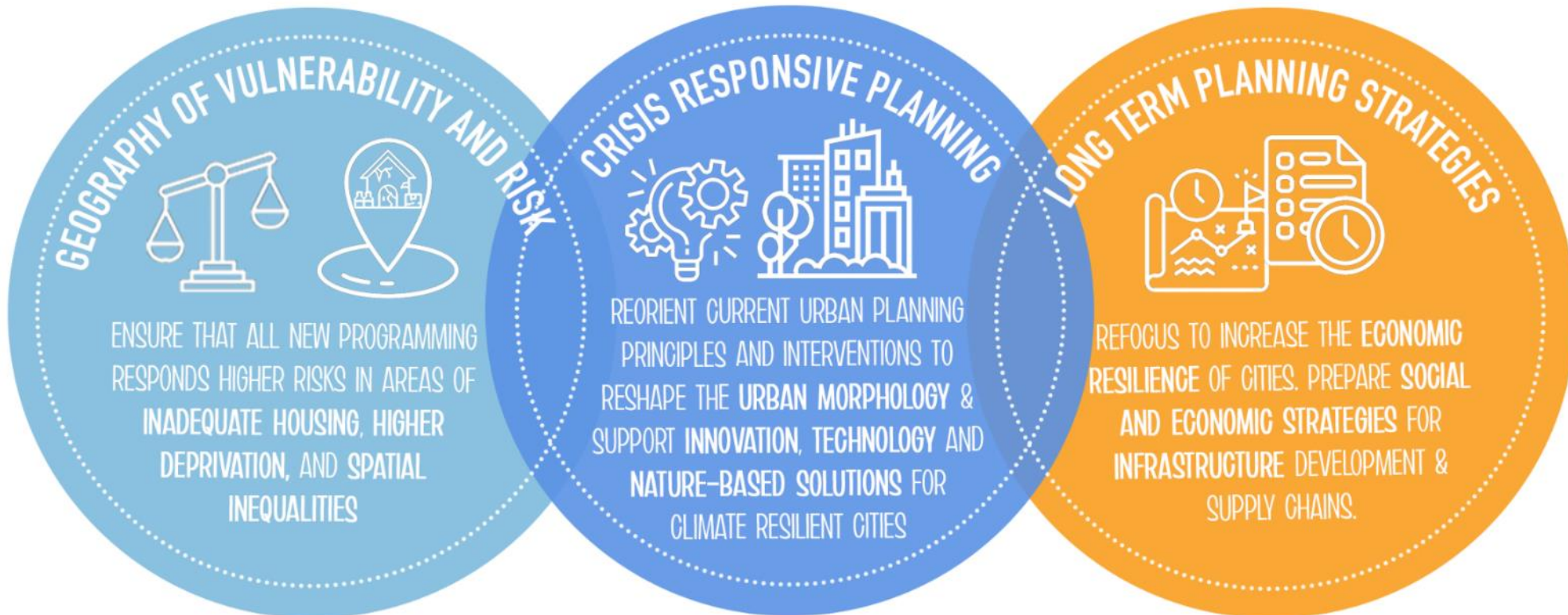

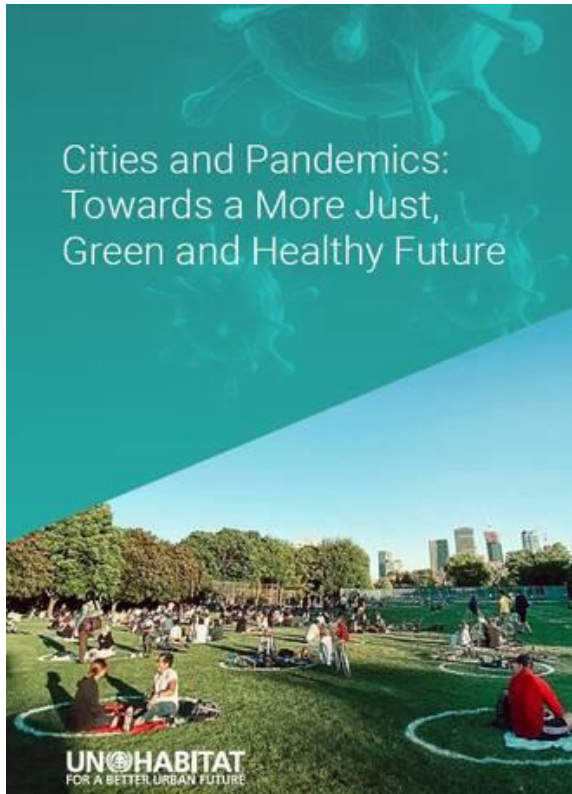

Housing

The right to adequate housing can support the reduction of poverty, exclusion, and inequality, and strengthen inclusive, planned, and sustainable urbanization.

Climate Action

Urban and local climate action with an emphasis on Climate Resilient Informal Settlements, multi-level governance and climate change planning in support of the achievement of the Paris Agreement.
