



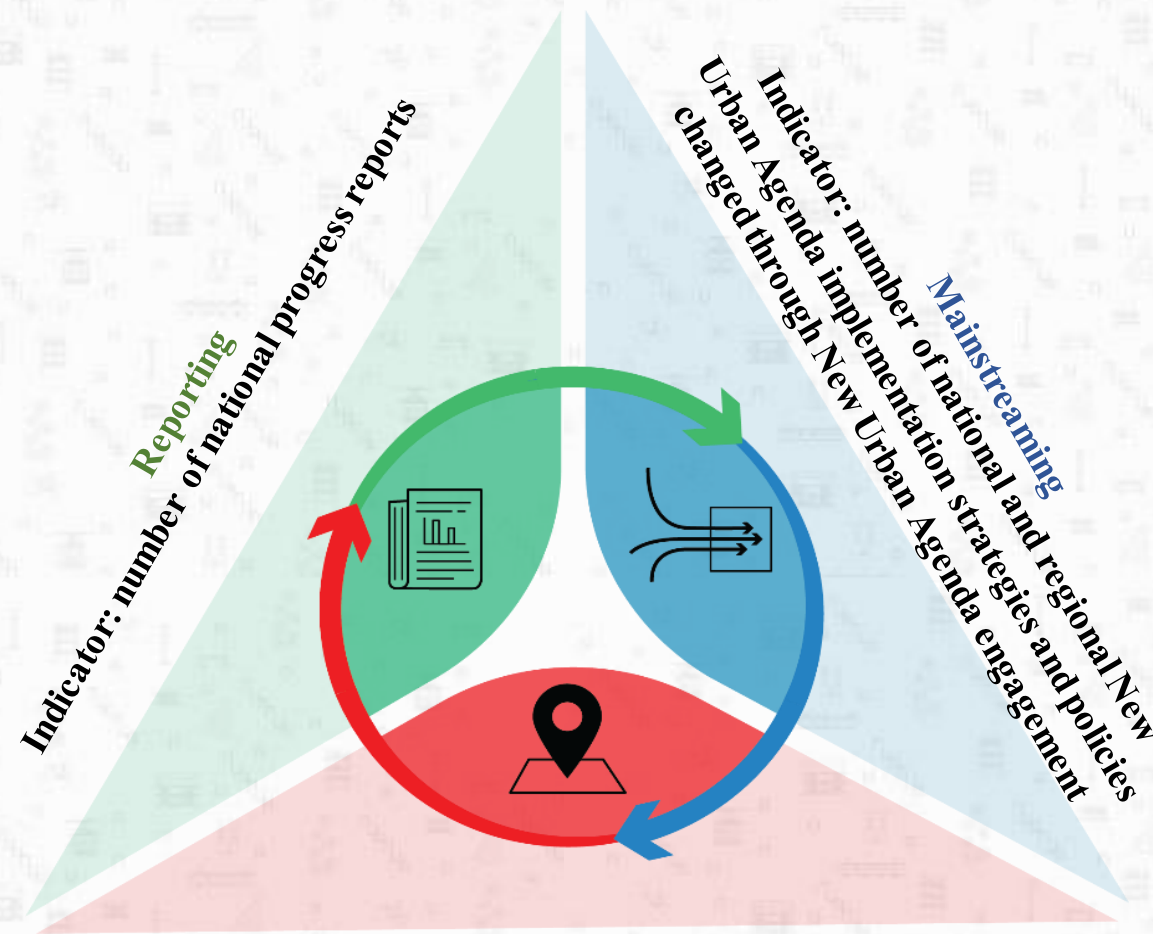

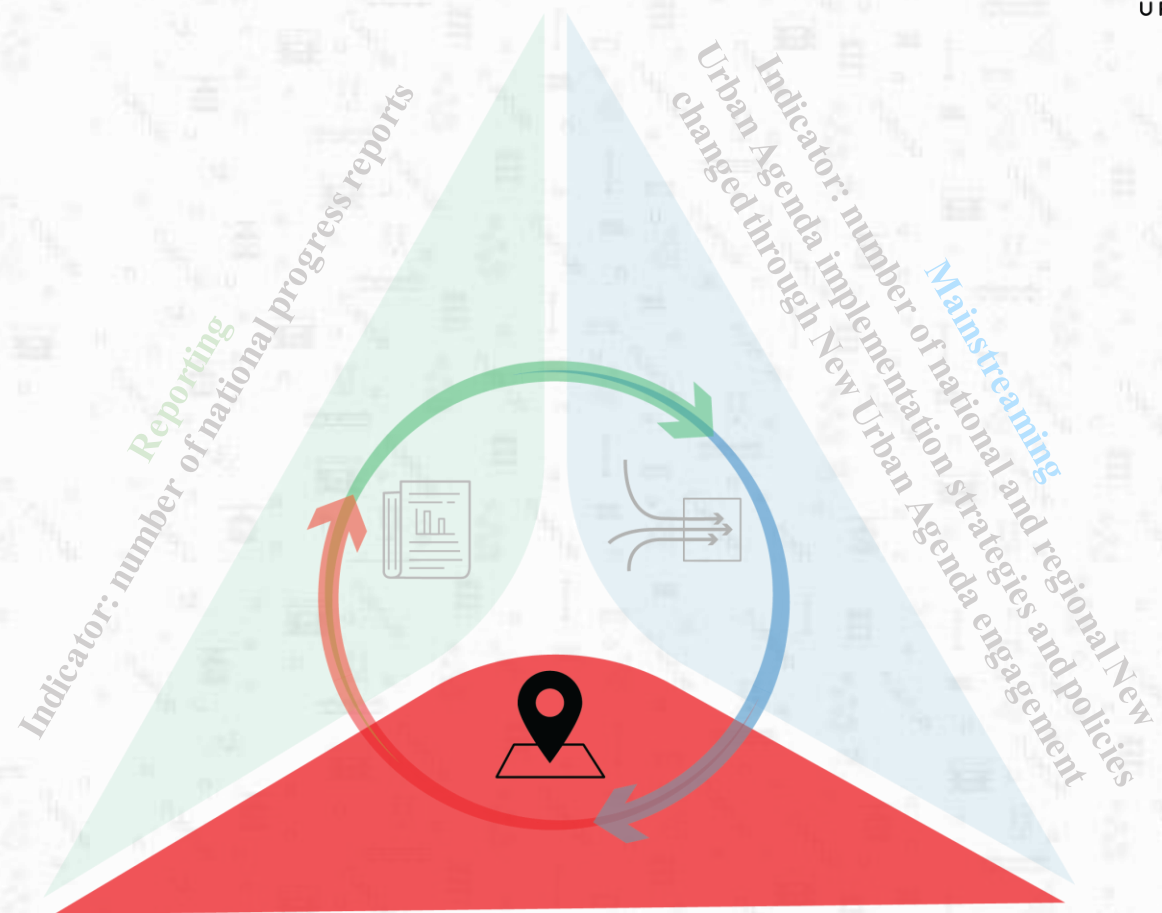

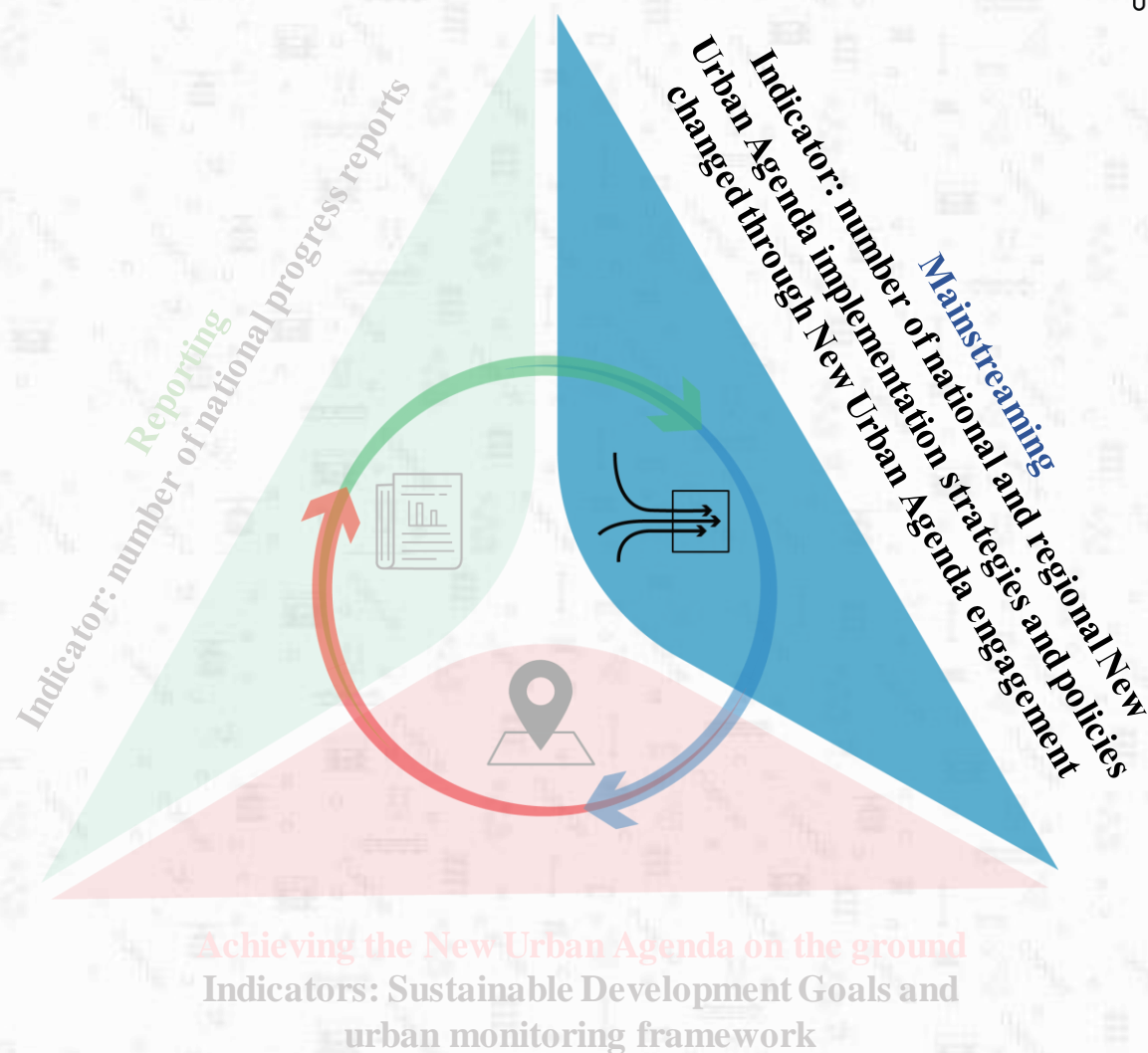
**Achieving the New Urban Agenda on the ground**  
Indicators: Sustainable Development Goals and urban monitoring framework

- Gaps in effective multi-level governance alignment, including limited policy integration;
- Limited effective planning and management of urban and territorial spatial development;
- Insufficiently inclusive and participatory approaches to urban planning and management;
- Insufficient financing;
- A lack of technical capacity.

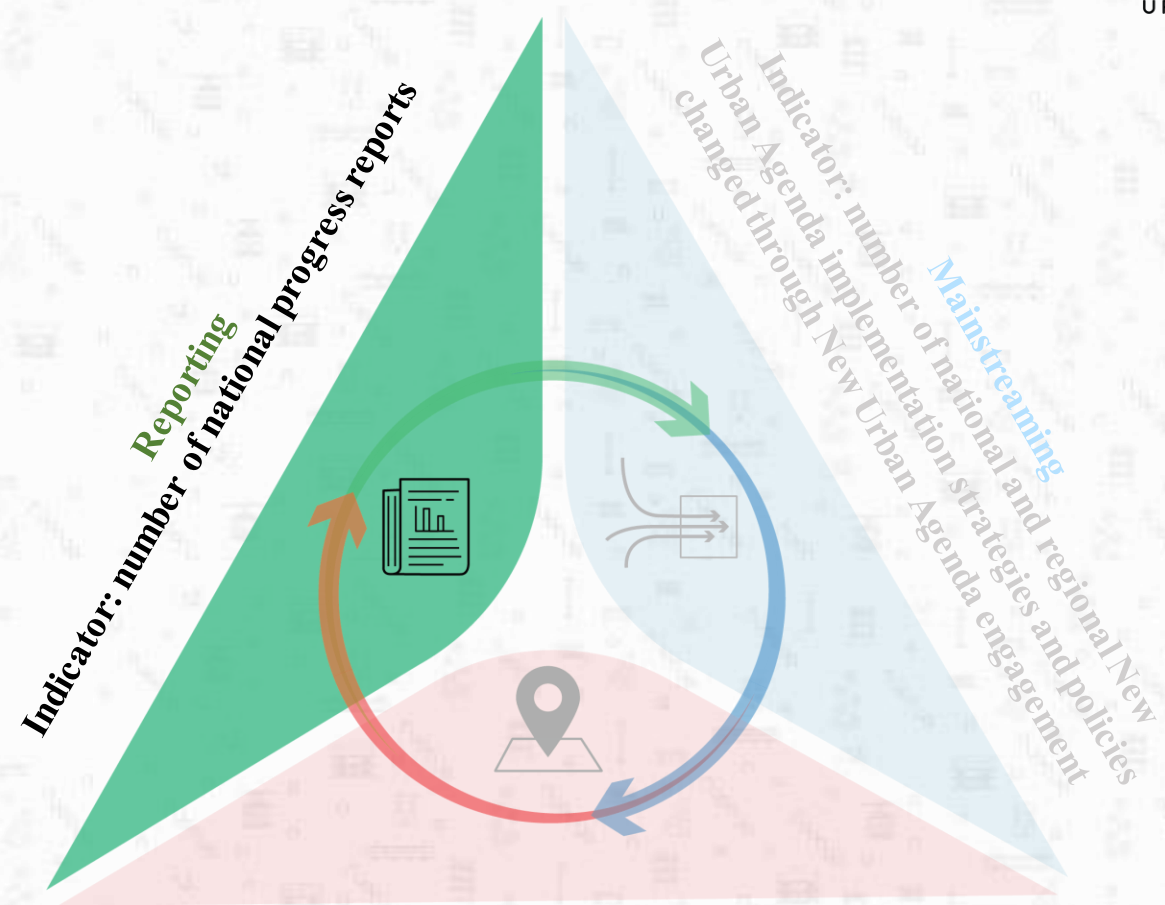


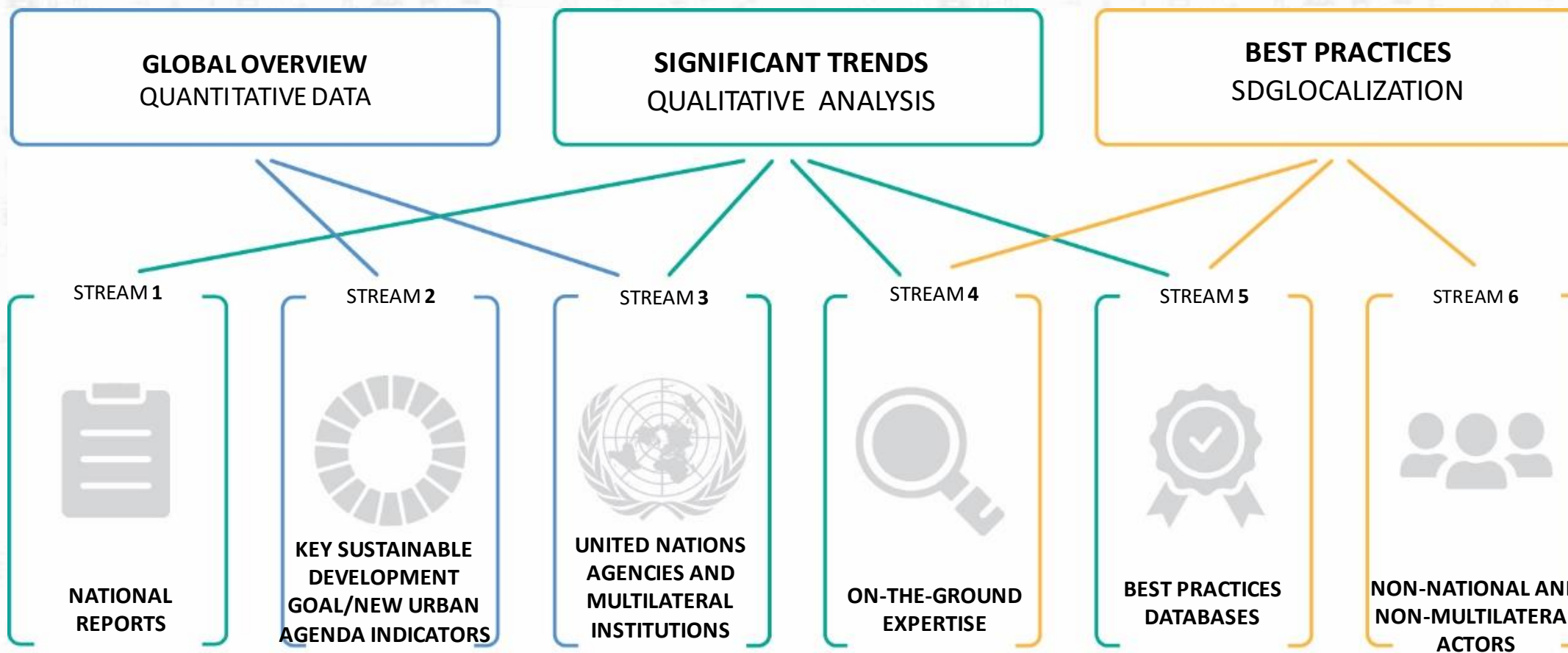
**Achieving the New Urban Agenda on the ground**  
**Indicators: Sustainable Development Goals and**  
**urban monitoring framework**

- Agenda lacks a prioritization framework;
- A lack of corresponding implementation targets, indicators and a monitoring plan;
- Low relative prioritization compared to other global agendas and frameworks;
- Gaps in their awareness and understanding of the NUA;
- Perceived competition between the New Urban Agenda and SDG11;
- Tools that support implementation, monitoring and reporting require proficiency in English.



- 40 countries currently submitted progress report;
- Limited resources and capacities to monitor and report;
- Concern on the substantial number of indicators that need to be collected;
- Low integration with NUP and NUF processes.
