




Regular budget vs Cash

Why is this happening?

- ✓ Member states are not paying in full
 - Only 142 paid in full, 82.3% collected, lowest in last 5 years
 - Arrears climbed to \$859M, a record high
- Cash reserves are nearly depleted
 - ❖ 2024 opened with only \$60M, compared to 2023 opening with \$700M
 - Without austerity measures, cash could be fully depleted by August
- ✓ The crisis is chronic
 - Hiring restrictions started 19 July 2023
 - The 'way out' is only with settlement of arrears






UN global impact in 2024

- ✓ Cuts in spending
 - 10-15% across all Secretariat entities
- ✓ Reduced operational footprint
 - Official travel limited to the most essential
 - Postponement of purchases
 - Suspension of construction and maintenance, closures of premises
 - Curtailment of non-essential security measures
- ✓ Non-delivery of programmes
 - Reporting on reduced or sacrificed deliverables




