05 > DECLARATION HIGHLIGHTS

The Cairo Declaration (16 June 2015) emphasizes the importance of dialogue, supporting reforms and effective measures for sustainable urbanization in accordance with the 2014 Egyptian Constitution.

The Principles highlight: Human beings as the focus of urban development, Quality of

life for all, Social Justice, Inclusion, Decentralization, Citizens Participation, Sustainability, and Preservation of Cultural Heritage.

Recommendations

- O Design a housing policy that addresses structural imbalances with the active collaboration of the community.
- O Develop the legal framework for a clear urban policy guideline to be consulted throughout the implementation, monitoring, and evaluation phases of urban renewal.
- O Enable local administration units to provide their own public services and facilities.
- O Encourage the participation of stakeholders during the urban upgrading processes at a local and national level.
- O Promote city resilience through the use of renewable sources of energy, public transport, an integrated solid waste management and a feasible urban strategic plan.
- O Create effective governmental evaluation procedures which guarantee the equal access of all citizens to housing facilities as well as to public services.
